In 2016, an innovative training academy was created together with Zwick Roell AG on the premises of the vocational training center run by the Salesians of Don Bosco. The global leader in the manufacturing of testing systems rented a 280m² building on the campus, renovated it, and equipped it with the most modern materials testing machines, now known as the Zwick Roell Academy.

Two trainers train up to twelve adolescents each year to become Zwick testing machine operators, giving them

the opportunity to lead a self-determined life that breaks the barriers of poverty. The Zwick Roell AG also uses the training facility for continued training activities and as the first Zwick lab in India for customer demonstrations and training courses. Besides the development of the project, the company also fully funds the operation of the training academy.

Pioneers in Education

The trainees from the academy's first year are true pioneers in their families. Many of them are the first to have ever

completed vocational training of any kind. Together, the nine young men and three young women are learning how to operate highly complex testing machines.

Take 17-year-old Kiran, for example. His parents died when he was a young boy. Relatives took him in. He was lucky enough to have the chance to go to school because the Salesians of Don Bosco are active in his impoverished neighborhood. There he learned of the vocational training opportunity. He moved to Chennai just for this apprenticeship, but because his relatives

have no money, Zwick Roell AG has assumed his school and training fees.

Traditional and Modern

India is one of the most economically interesting and thriving countries. It promises a growing industrial labor market, but there are very few opportunities for vocational training. And although there is a national chartered right to education, social factors such as caste and place of residence still dictate a young person's access to education. One third of young Indians are unemployed and get through by doing odd jobs. For almost 100 years, the Salesians of Don Bosco have been actively helping youth obtain an education, giving them a chance of a profession and better life.
